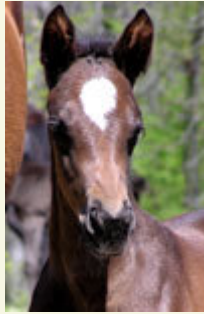
ADVERTISING
